BACKGROUND:

Police Chief Howard Williams will retire effective August 1, 2014. Civil Service Statute 143.013 requires the City Manager to appoint his replacement with a confirmation by the San Marcos City Council. Mr. Miller will appoint Chase Stapp as Police Chief effective August 2, 2014 pending this confirmation.

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN MARCOS, TEXAS CONFIRMING THE CITY MANAGER'S APPOINTMENT OF CHASE STAPP AS CHIEF AND HEAD OF THE SAN MARCOS POLICE DEPARTMENT; AND DECLARING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

RECITALS:

1. Under Section 143.013 of the Texas Local Government Code, the chief or head of the Police Department is to be appointed by the chief executive officer of the city and confirmed by the municipal governing body.

2. The City Manager has appointed Chase Stapp to serve as chief and head of the San Marcos Police Department for all lawful purposes effective August 2, 2014.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN MARCOS, TEXAS:

PART 1. The San Marcos City Council hereby confirms the City Manager's appointment of Chase Stapp as chief and head of the San Marcos Police Department for all lawful purposes effective August 2, 2014. Howard Williams shall continue to be the chief and head of the San Marcos Police Department until and including August 1, 2014.

PART 2. This resolution shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage.
